1. The workshop was attended by all the Teaching Faculty of the College of Fine Arts, Karnataka Chitrakala Parishath. 

However, this need to be practiced very strictly in all examinations. It is also decided to display large posters with detailed text of rules and regulations of examination for the students, which would create some awareness and seriousness about the examination.

4. The workshop concluded with thanks to the chair and it is also decided to have series of such workshops for the teaching faculty in the coming semesters. Coordinator agreed that there shall be syllabus awareness workshop for both students as well as the teachers in the next semester.
